

I, _____, declare as follows:

1. For more than 25 years, I had a serious addiction to drugs, including methamphetamine and heroin. I had turned to drugs, in part, to deal with the pain of my experiences when I was young, including being placed into foster care at the age of 13. I felt the need to feed my addiction, which led me to commit crimes. I deeply regret my actions and take full responsibility for the poor choices I made.
2. In August of 2008, I made the decision to change my life. I completed a recovery home program and am proud to say that I have remained clean and sober from all mood altering substances for 15 years. I have accomplished more than I would ever have thought possible. I have tried to better myself in all areas of my life and getting my record expunged would be an important milestone in that journey.
3. I worked hard to rebuild my relationships with my family. I obtained custody of my son, and I hope to set a positive example for him.
4. I enrolled in community college and received my certificate and associate degree in Alcohol and Drug Studies.
5. I am currently employed by the Military & Veterans Success Center at Imperial Valley College in Imperial County, California. I find my work fulfilling and rewarding and would like to continue my career working with veterans. If my records are expunged, I can seek a promotion to become a Program Specialist. I have previously been denied due to failing a background check. This is an opportunity I would be grateful for and excited to pursue.
6. My faith is very important to me, and since becoming sober, I have focused on becoming an active member of my church and giving back to my community. I regularly attend church at Victory Outreach in El Centro and have volunteered in a number of capacities, including as a greeter, security guard, chapel teacher and youth leader. I also help distribute food to those in need through my employer and participate in job fairs, veterans events and mental health workshops.
7. As an active member of society who has worked hard to contribute and do my part, I would like to officially put my past to rest and have the burden of my past convictions expunged. I am eager to put my past firmly behind me and am grateful for your

consideration of the expungement of my records.

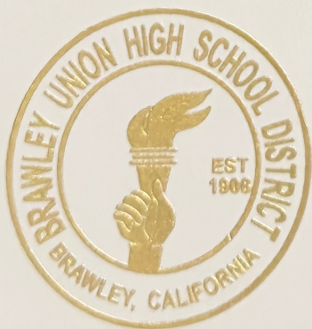
