I had turned to drugs, in part, to deal with the pain of my experiences when I was young, including being placed into foster care at the age of 13. I felt the need to feed my addiction, which led me to commit crimes. I deeply regret my actions and take full responsibility for the poor choices I made.
2. I \_\_\_\_\_ I made the decision to change my life. I completed a recovery home program and am proud to say that I have remained clean and sober from all mood altering substances for 15 years. I have accomplished more than I would ever have thought possible. I have tried to better myself in all areas of my life and getting my record expunged would be an important milestone in that journey.
3. I worked hard to rebuild my relationships with my family. I obtained custody of my son, and I hope to set a positive example for him.
4. I enrolled in community college and received my certificate and associate degree in Alcohol and Drug Studies.
5. I am currently employed by the Military & Veterans Success Center at \_\_\_\_\_ I find my work fulfilling and rewarding and would like to continue my career working with veterans. If my records are expunged, I can seek a promotion to become a \_\_\_\_\_ I have previously been denied due to failing a background check. This is an opportunity I would be grateful for and excited to pursue.
6. My faith is very important to me, and since becoming sober, I have focused on becoming an active member of my church and giving back to my community. 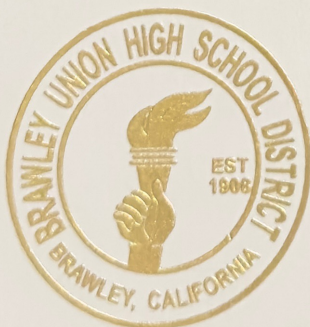
